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INTRODUCTION

This manual has been prepared in accordance with section 51 of the Act and aims to facilitate a request for access to a record held by a private body that is required for the exercise or protection of any legally applicable rights.

DEFINITIONS

Unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the following terms shall have the meanings assigned to them hereunder, namely

- "Act" means the Promotion of Access to Information Act, Act 2 of 2000, as amended from time to time;
- "N2P" means the Number Two Piggeries Group as more fully described in the overview hereunder:
- "Information Officer" means the person acting on behalf of N2P and discharging the duties and responsibilities assigned to the head of N2P by the Act. The Information Officer is duly authorised to conduct the responsibilities of the Information Officer and such authorisation has been confirmed by the CEO of N2P in writing;
- "Information Regulator" is an independent body established in terms of section 39 of the Protection of Personal Information act 4 of 2013;
- "Manual" means this manual published in compliance with Section 51 of the Act;
- "Record" means any recorded information, regardless of form or medium, which is in the possession or under the control of N2P, irrespective of whether or not it was created by N2P;
- "Request" means a request for access to a record of N2P;
- "Requestor" means any person, including a public body or an official thereof, making a request for access to a record of N2P and includes any person acting on behalf of that person; and
- "SAHRC" means the South African Human Rights Commission.

Unless a contrary intention clearly appears, words signifying:

- the singular includes the plural and vice versa;
- any one gender includes the other genders and vice versa; and
- natural persons include juristic persons. Unless otherwise stated, terms defined in the Act shall have the same meaning in this manual.

GUIDE TO THE ACT (SECTION 51(1)(b))

The Act grants a requester access to records of a private body, if the record is required for the exercise or protection of any legally applicable rights. If a public body lodges a request, the public body must be acting in the public interest.

Requests in terms of the Act shall be made in accordance with the prescribed procedures, at the rates provided. The forms and tariff are dealt with in paragraphs 6 and 7 of the Act.

Requesters are referred to the guide in terms of Section 10 which has been compiled by the South African Human Rights Commission, which will contain information for the purposes of exercising Constitutional Rights. The guide is available from the SAHRC and subsequent to 1 July 2021 from the Information Regulator.

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FORM OF REQUEST (SECTION 51 (1) (E)) & PRESCRIBED FEES (SECTION 51 (1) (F))

How to request a record (Section 53):

- Requests for access to records must be made to the Information Officer in the prescribed form, at the address, or electronic mail address referred to above. Failure to make use of the prescribed form could result in your request being refused or delayed.
- A request for access to a record must be accompanied by payment of an initial nonrefundable request fee of R57.00 (inclusive of VAT). This fee is not applicable to personal requests, i.e. an individual seeking access to records pertaining him/herself.
- The requestor must provide sufficient detail on the request form to enable the Information Officer to clearly identify the record as well as the requestor's identify, which is to be accompanied by positive proof of identification.
- The requestor must indicate which form of access is required and if he/she wishes to be informed on the decision on the request in any other manner, to state the necessary particulars to be so informed.
- Access is not automatic. The requestor must therefore identify the right he/she is seeking to
 exercise or protect and provide an explanation as to why the requested record is required for
 the exercise or protection of that right.
- If a request is made on behalf of another person, the requestor must then submit proof, to the satisfaction of the Information Officer, of his/her authority to make the request. Failure to do so will result in the request being rejected.

Decision on request (Section 56):

- The requestor will be notified, within 30 days, in the manner indicated by him/her of the
 outcome of his/her request, alternatively whether an extension not exceeding 30 days is
 required to deal with the request.
 - If the request for access is granted a further access fee must be paid for the reproduction as well as the search and preparation of the records and for any time that has exceeded the prescribed hours to search and prepare the record for disclosure. Access will be withheld until the requestor has made payment of the applicable fee(s).
 - In the event that the request for access is refused, reasons for the refusal will be provided and the requestor will be advised the he/she may lodge an application with a court against the refusal of the request, as well as the procedure for lodging the application.
- The requestor may lodge an internal appeal or an application to court against the tender or payment of the request fee.
